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This is my first vintage of Scythians, a dry white wine made from the Palomino grape. I sourced the grapes from a Demeter certified biodynamic farm near Fresno, CA. Palomino is a non-aromatic white grape variety that is indigenous to Spain. If you've had dry Sherry (not the sweet stuff), you've had the Palomino grape.

The 2019 Scythians is a dry table wine, crafted to drink young. For those of you who know me and know my penchant for high acid wines, Palomino is a famously low acid grape. This wine is all about texture and juiciness. The wine is salty and a bit unctuous with notes of almond skin and yellow apple. Scythians is the perfect accompaniment to almonds, olives, sardines, and all the other salty and briny things you snack on before dinner.
